NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council consider it necessary or expedient by reason of works being executed on the following length of road that the prohibition should come into force without delay under **Section 14(2)(a)** of the **Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, which will temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this Notice.

- 1. No person shall cause any class of traffic to proceed over that length of Waddington Road, West Bradford from its junction with Clitheroe Road to its junction with Eaves Hall Lane.
- 2. Nothing in this notice shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative from 1030 hours on 9th October 2024 until 1400 hours on 10th October 2024 or until completion of the works within this period. The prohibitions will only be operative when indicated on site by the presence of the appropriate traffic signs in accordance with The Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016
- 4. A diversion will be signed locally.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow Lancashire County Council to carry out urgent carriageway repair works.
